3	Functions	To monitor the outcomes of the provincial Healthy Child Development Strategy; to issue an Annual Report on Children on PEI; to host an annual Think Tank on children's issues; to participate in and promote public education on the importance of the early years; and to provide advise on a workplan for children.

5	Composition	A full complement would be eight members, including the Chair.
6	Formal Qualifications	no specific formal qualifications needed
7	Work & Experience Requirements	No specific work and experience required, see Skills Required and Traditional Nomination Requirements.
8	Skills Required	Individuals who bring a perspective from health (pediatrician), education, justice, or business; a parent of a child with a disability; a teen parent; a grandparent; a representative of the Francophone community; or a representative from the child protection field.
9	Statutory Nomination Requirements	None
10	Traditional Nomination Requirements	Membership will be representative of the diversity of the Island population, and be sensitive to gender equity. Members will be appointed based on their individual strengths and expertise in matters related to healthy child development in the prenatal to early school years period of development.
11	Remuneration	Costs for honoraria and authorized expenses incurred to attend meetings.
12	Anticipated Time Commitments	The Council meets quarterly. Terms last for two year with the possibility of extension.
