## **General Educational Development Tests (GED)**

### **Requirements:**

Individuals wishing to write the GED tests must meet all of the following requirements:

1. The candidate must be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.
2. The candidate must be at least 18 years of age.
3. The candidate must be out of school for one year.
4. The candidate must not have received a Grade 12 graduation certificate from any other institution
5. The candidate must call Holland College at 1-800-446-5265 (option # 3) to arrange to take the official practice test prior to being able to schedule the GED tests.

### **Procedure:**

1. Complete **all** sections of the application form.
2. Return completed application one of three ways:

Applicants who fail to appear for a testing session and who have not given notice will be required to wait up to 6 months to re-register.
