Assignment of Additional Designation in School Counselling
CSB 13-02

Pursuant to Chapter S-2.1, Section 14 of the Certification and Standards Board Regulations of the *School Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. S-2.1, I hereby approve the following Certification and Standards Board Policy concerning Additional Designations for teachers in the area of School Counselling.

An Additional Designation in School Counselling may be assigned to the holder of a valid P.E.I. Academic Teacher's Certificate upon submission to the Registrar of the required documentation including proof of ...

1. completion of a recognized masters degree in counselling, counselling psychology or a related discipline with a focus on counselling from an accredited university that includes

i) training in counselling theory

ii) a supervised counselling practicum

iii) graduate courses in five of the following area: *communication and relationship skills, group counselling, career development, research and evaluation, consultation methods, learning and human development, psychological education, counselling interventions and strategies, multi-cultural counselling, counselling in specialized settings, counselling ethics, psycho-educational assessment*

2. eligibility for Canadian Counsellor Certification (CCC), Canadian Counselling Association or full Canadian Counsellor Certification (CCC), Canadian Counselling Association
