8. Declaration of Applicant:

As applicant, I hereby request a permit to commence, make or carry out the watercourse/wetland/buffer zone activity as described on this application form. It is understood that by submitting this application it does not allow the applicant to commence, make or carry out the alteration described herein.

It is understood that the issuance of a permit does not exempt the applicant from the provisions of any act of the Legislature of Prince Edward Island or the Parliament of Canada or any due process of law. It is acknowledged that the issuance of a permit does not serve to deprive any person of his or her rights either under statute or common law to claim damages for the loss or injury caused to his or her property by reason of the watercourse/wetland alteration. It is understood that the issuance of a permit places no liability upon the Minister of the Department of Environment, Energy and Forestry.

It is understood that for the purpose of application review, staff from the Department of Environment, Energy and Forestry at any reasonable time may enter the property as identified in sections 2 and 3 of this application.

If issued a permit, it is agreed that only such work as approved by the permit shall be carried out and all such work shall be done according to the permit and within the designated time frame so as to cause a minimum of disturbance to the watercourse/wetland/buffer zone.

As applicant, I have read and understood section 35 of the *Environmental Protection Act* that states, "Where contamination or damage of any kind is caused by failure of any person to comply with provisions of this Act or regulations and where the contamination or damage relates to a matter which in the opinion of the Minister requires immediate action to prevent further injury to the environment, the Minister may take the appropriate remedial action to clean up the contamination or damage." Any remedial action taken under section 35 may be at the cost of the applicant or the property owner.
