CHAPTER J-2.1
JUDICATURE ACT
SMALL CLAIMS REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 70 of the *Judicature Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. J-2.1, Council made the following regulations:

1. In these regulations, “Act” means the *Judicature Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Act, defined Cap. J-2.1. (EC741/08)
2. For the purposes of section 15 of the Act, the maximum sum of a claim that may be brought in an action commenced in the Small Claims Section of the Supreme Court is \$8,000. ^{Maximum sum of claim} (EC741/08)
