Eligibility for Youth Talent Search

Contestants MUST be permanent residents of Prince Edward Island. Open to non-professional performers only, between the ages of 13 and 21 years. Each member of an act, whether performing as a soloist or as a member of a group, must be at least 13 years old and must not have reached their twenty-second birthday by the opening day of the current year's participating fairs.

For the purpose of the Youth Talent Search, a professional entertainer is:

- a. One who earns more than \$16,000 (after cost recovery) in earned entertainment dollars in a given year.
- b. One who is a union member, or
- c. One who has a "professional" agent or manager securing employment in the entertainment field, or
- d. One who sings or is the principal performer on any CD released for commercial distribution through contracts with recording companies paid to promote them. (This does NOT prohibit an entertainer from self-producing a CD for sale or distribution to friends and associates such as in church group activities or friendly retail outlets.)

Proof of age may be required.

Participants may enter in **one or two categories** at each of the PEI Youth Talent Search Competitions. If the contestant **enters in only one category** and wins the competition, he/she will move on to the Provincial Finals and are not eligible to continue competing. If a participant chooses to **enter two categories** in the same competition and wins with one act,, they are still eligible to compete at future competitions with the act that did not win.

To compete in future competitions, the contestant must register and compete in the same category, with the same members of the group or duet they originally competed with. Simple clarification: The winner cannot alter the group configuration in the second category act by changing dancers, singing partners, band members or the band name. The contestants must remain the same and enter in the same category. No exceptions. For example, a dancer competes as a solo and as part of a duet or group. If the solo dancer advances, the dancer can still compete as a part of the duet or group, but only with the same people originally in the second category.

A participant who has previously won the PEI Youth Talent Competition Finals is no longer eligible to compete in future PEI Youth Talent Competitions.

Recorded Music for Accompaniment

Effective January 1st, 2017

Contestants are responsible for the quality of the music downloaded. Contestants must bring a backup download in case of a faulty disc or corrupted download. Acceptable formats for recorded music are: CD, Mp3 players, iPhones and USB sticks.

Categories

Categories of competition are as follows:

1. Vocal Solo
2. Instrumental Solo
3. Dance Solo
4. Vocal Group
5. Instrumental Group
6. Dance Group
7. Variety Solo
8. Variety Group

Note: There is no limit to the number of members in a group.

Note: Competition categories are for the purposes of scheduling performers, clarifying eligibility and determining judging criteria. Each act will be judged against each other act, regardless of the category of performance.

Competition

Participants may enter in **one or two categories** at each of the PEI Youth Talent Search Competitions. If the contestant **enters in only one category** and wins the competition, he/she will move on to the Provincial Finals and are not eligible to continue competing. If a participant chooses to **enter two categories** in the same competition and wins with one act,, they are still eligible to compete at future competitions with the act that did not win. To compete in future competitions, the contestant must register and compete in the same category, with the same members of the group or duet they originally competed with. Simple clarification: The winner cannot alter the group configuration in the second category act by changing dancers, singing partners, band members or the band name. The contestants must remain the same and enter in the same category. **No exceptions.** For example, a dancer competes as a solo and as part of a duet or group. A participant who has previously won the PEI Youth Talent Competition Finals is no longer eligible to compete in future PEI Youth Talent Competitions.

General Rules and Regulations of Judging

Contestants will be judged on the following basis:

- Natural Ability–25%
- Quality of Performance–25%
- Showmanship and Suitable Appearance–25%
- Audience Rapport–25%

There will be a minimum of three judges for each local competition. Decision of the contest judges is final. No discussion regarding any decisions shall be entered into by the Youth Talent Search organizers.

Participant Rules and Regulations

- Acts may not run longer than 4 1/2 minutes. Acts running over this time will be disqualified.
- Contestants must choose age and language appropriate song lyrics.

To ensure that your act meets the rules and regulations of the Provincial Youth Talent Competition, please read the complete rules and regulations for the competition at www.peiae.ca. Failure to comply with the rules and regulations will result in disqualification from the event.

Please note: Contestants must choose age and language appropriate song lyrics. At the judge's discretion, songs containing coarse or suggestive language may result in disqualification.

Cash Awards Presented For:

First Place: \$300

Second Place: \$150

Third Place: \$75

Note: This is the mandatory limit set for prize money, however if an event has the capacity to increase the amounts they may do so at their own discretion.

Provincial Youth Talent Search Finals

The final competition will be held at the region Evangeline recreation centre on Friday August 31st during the opening ceremonies of L'Exposition agricole et le Festival acadien de la region Evangeline. The winner will receive \$750 in prize money, the runner-up will receive \$350 and the third place contestant will receive \$150.
