Travel Instructions

Please read carefully & mark travel dates on your calendar

Requirements

- ✓ The applicant must have completed at least two years in the 4-H program.
- ✓ The applicant must have met all of the 4-H Year Completion Requirements in the previous year.
- ✓ The applicant must be an active 4-H member when he/she applies for the travel program **and** when he/she goes on the travel program.
- ✓ **The applicant must be 16 years of age as of the start date of the conference:**
 - National 4-H Dairy Conference (Madison, WI) October 3-7, 2017 (Age 15-18 as of event date)
TWO members may be selected for 2017
 - U.S. National 4-H Conference (Washington, DC) April 7-12, 2018 (Age 16-19 as of event date)
ONE member may be selected for this 2018 travel opportunity.
 - 4-H Canada Citizenship Congress (Ottawa, Ontario) May 1-6, 2018 (Ages 16-19 as of the event)
SEVEN spaces are available to 4-H PEI members for this 2018 travel opportunity.
 - 4-H Canada – National Members' Forum (Toronto, ON) **Not offered as a 2017 travel opportunity.**
- ✓ Applicants are eligible to apply for ALL programs (age permitting). **Please rank trip choice(s) where indicated on the application form.** (If applicant has been on a National or International Travel Program before, he/she is eligible to apply for the same program again).
- ✓ Applicants **may** be chosen as a participant for more than one travel opportunity.
- ✓ Selection criteria will be based on: **Application, Past & Present 4-H Experience, 4-H Knowledge & Interview**
- ✓ The applicant who, at the time of selection, is a permanent paid employee of 4-H shall not be eligible for consideration.

Instructions

- ✓ Only **one** application form is required. Please use a **pen with blue or black ink** to fill out application (for photocopying purposes).
- ✓ Do not assume that information is known about you – use detail.
- ✓ Interviews will be scheduled for **Saturday, May 27th, 2017** – applicants will be notified of interview time.
- ✓ ***New 2017*** In an effort to shorten the interview process and use time more effectively all applicants will be required to write a Quiz based on 4-H Knowledge (Club, District, Provincial & National) and Political Knowledge following their in-person interview.

Please Note: National 4-H participant selections for the 2017/18 programs are tentative and will be subject to funding as secured by the Canadian 4-H Council.

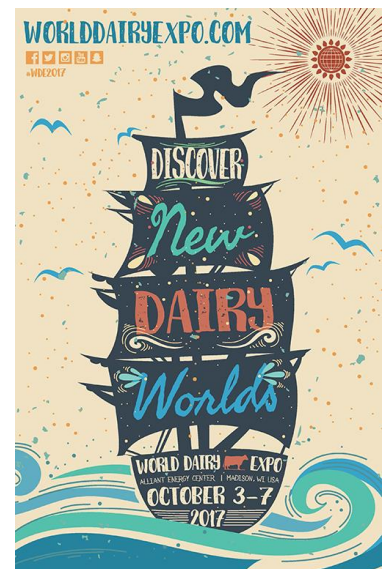
****Financial Expectations for National 4-H Dairy Conference:**
