- Children exposed to domestic violence or parents/caregivers of children killed in the context of domestic violence

We want to learn from people with experiences that occurred between 2006 and 2016.

Participants must be at least 18 years and willing to have their interview recorded. Interviews can be in the language you are comfortable speaking as long as we can find an appropriate interpreter and will take approximately one to two hours to complete.

Each person who participates will be offered a \$50 gift card to thank you for your time.

You can share your story with us by phone, video conference, or in-person at the Western University or Guelph University or a local agency. If needed, travel and/or childcare costs will be covered.

We will work with you to protect your safety and privacy.
