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6.0 IDENTIFICATION OF SUPPORT COORDINATOR

- 6.1 A Support Coordinator may be identified. A Support Coordinator may be the person with the disability or the parent or guardian of a person with a disability. It may be a family member, or someone who is identified to provide this service. It may be someone from a disability organization or it may be the Disability Support Worker (Refer to Section 2.3.1 and 3.3.3).
- 6.2 The Disability Support Worker must discuss with the individual or family the role and functions of a Support Coordinator (Refer to Section 2.3.2).
- 6.3 Where a Support Coordinator is required, the individual or family, in consultation with the Disability Support Worker, must determine who the Support Coordinator will be and designate that person as the Support Coordinator.
