

Important Information for Provincial Nominee Applicants

Citizenship and Immigration Canada has changed how it processes permanent resident visa applications submitted by provincial nominees.

Effective December 1, 2011 all provincial nominees must submit their permanent resident applications to CIC's new centralized intake office in Sydney, Nova Scotia. For details visit CIC's website at: cic.gc.ca/english/immigrate/provincial/apply-application.asp

Other changes include:

- a unified document checklist for all provincial nominees, regardless of their country of residence. This checklist can be found at cic.gc.ca/english/immigrate/provincial/apply-application.asp

- provincial nominees must include their processing fee at the time they send their application to the centralized intake office.
