## How to make a nomination

Do you know a person, organization or business whom you would describe as a "Literacy Leader"?

You can nominate a person, organization or business who:

- resides or is located in Prince Edward Island;
- has demonstrated leadership in involvement in the field of literacy;
- has inspired others; and
- has demonstrated a commitment to lifelong learning.

Please provide:

1. A completed nomination form (attached).
2. An outline describing and including specific examples of:
  - how the nominee has demonstrated leadership in the field of literacy;
  - how the nominee has inspired others;
  - awards and/or recognition received; and
  - the nominee's commitment to lifelong learning.The outline should be no more than two typewritten pages.
3. Two letters of support:
  - one of the letters must be from a person, organization, business, learning institution or government body who can validate the nominee's contributions; and
  - one from another who has been inspired by the nominee. Letters of support must be a maximum of two typewritten pages and provide specific examples describing:
    - why the nominee deserves the award,
    - how the nominee has demonstrated leadership in the field of literacy, and
    - the nominee's commitment to lifelong learning.
