



Men Matter is a male centered group program being offered for male survivors of sexual abuse in PEI by the PEI Rape and Sexual Assault Centre (PEIRSAC). There is no charge to participants. All groups are led by two facilitators.

PEIRSAC is now accepting registrations for the Phase I Men Matter Group that will run this winter (dates TBD) in Charlottetown.

Phase 1 Groups

Phase I is a 10-session/10-week group program. Its purpose is to prepare men for their journey of trauma recovery by learning more about the impacts of abuse and expanding coping skills. Group members are not required to divulge personal information to the group. Group size is 6 – 8 participants led by two facilitators. Sessions are all free of charge. It is expected that participants attend all sessions.
