Emergency Operations Centre (EOC)

Purpose:

- This course prepares participants to carry out their roles as members of an Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) team. The EOC course trains participants to effectively manage and coordinate the overall operations within their municipality or organization while also providing the necessary support to the site during a multi-service response to an emergency.

Content:

- Emergency Management Overview
- Emergency Operations Centre Facility
- Emergency Operations Centre Team
- Operational Planning Cycle
- EOC Documentation

Who should attend?

- The course is intended for senior level emergency management personnel, that have a role to play in their Emergency Operations Centre, including municipal management officials, fire, police, EMS, public works, health and social services, provincial departments, commissions, agencies, volunteer organizations and EOC support staff.

Course Certification:

- A Certificate will be issued once participants participate in all class lessons and activities.

Prerequisite:

- The Basic Emergency Management Course
- Incident Command System 100 (ICS 100)
- The participant must also have a decision-making role in the Emergency Operations Centre.
