



Incident Command System 100 (ICS 100) Self Study

Purpose:

- ICS 100 is intended for personnel assigned to an incident or event who have a minimum requirement for understanding ICS. This module reviews the ICS organization, basic terminology, and common responsibilities. It will provide enough information about the Incident Command System to enable you to work in a support role at an incident or event, or to support an incident from an off-site location.

Content:

- ICS 100 is designed to help you learn the principles of the Incident Command System and to briefly acquaint you with the basic ICS structure and terminology.

Delivery:

- This course has been developed as a self-study course enabling participants to progress as time allows. However, participants will be asked to complete the material which involves reading and completing self-administered, open-book, multiple-choice tests in a designated period of time.

Who should attend?

- This is an orientation for entry-level personnel assisting at an incident or event, persons working in support roles, and off-incident personnel who require a minimum of ICS orientation.
- This module may also be used as the required prerequisite pre-course study program by personnel who will be continuing their training with additional modules.

Course Certification:

- A Certificate will be issued once participants successfully complete the self study test.

Prerequisite:

- Completion of the Basic Emergency Management course is considered an asset.
