It's All About YOUth focuses on healthy relationships and encourages youth to examine all the various relationships in their lives. It covers healthy vs unhealthy relationships; interpersonal boundaries, feelings & communication; conflict vs disagreements; bullying/cyberbullying; media literacy; communicating assertively; self-esteem and confidence. The 6 week program is currently presented to grade 7 students at Montague Junior High, Birchwood Intermediate, Gulf Shore Consolidated, and Athena Consolidated schools.

SAVE (Students Against Violence Everywhere) is a student driven organization. It is designed to raise awareness about the issues of relationship abuse, family violence and where to go for help. Members meet once a week and participate in various activities and community service projects. This program is currently active in Montague, Morell and Souris high schools.
