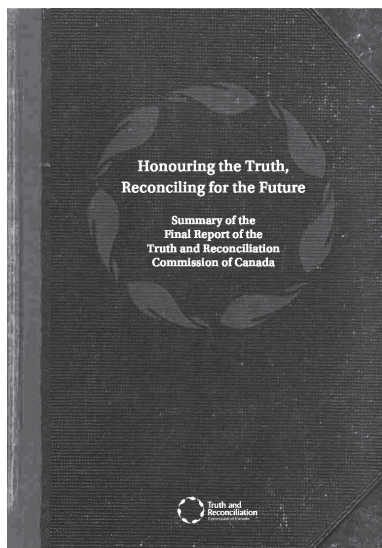

STUDY GROUP *on Canada's* Truth & Reconciliation Commission *at the* Confederation Centre Public Library
