LETTER OF ASSIGNMENT

In accordance with section 3 of the *Police Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-11.1 (the “Act”), the Minister is responsible for policing in the province and for the administration of the Act and regulations thereunder. In order to promote the preservation of peace, the prevention of crime, and the efficiency, adequacy and effectiveness of police services, I am further authorized to issue directives to any police service, the Atlantic Police Academy, or an employer of a security police officer to achieve these objectives.

An essential component of the administration of the Act is the ability to ensure that police services, the Atlantic Police Academy, and employers of security police officers are compliant with any such directives issued and that those directives are achieving their desired outcomes.

THEREFORE, pursuant to sub-section 18(1) of the Act, I hereby assign to the Police Commissioner for the Province of Prince Edward Island, the following functions:

1. Conduct reviews of police services, the Atlantic Police Academy, and employers of security police officers to determine levels of compliance with Ministerial Directives. Said reviews should occur at such intervals as are set out in any Ministerial Directives, or as are deemed necessary by the Police Commissioner in order to ensure that the desired outcomes are achieved;
2. Upon completion of a review as contemplated in paragraph 1 above, prepare a report of findings of the review for submission to the Minister, with a copy to be provided to the Manager of Policing Services, Department of Justice and Public Safety; and

3. Make available to the public a copy of all reports of findings of a review as contemplated in paragraph 1 above.

The assignment of these functions to the Police Commissioner shall come into effect on 15th
June, 2015.
