The Queen Elizabeth Hospital (QEH), Charlottetown PEI is seeking a physician leader to join the senior management team as Medical Director. The Medical Director will provide medical leadership to the Medical Staff of the QEH and will work collaboratively with others in the Health PEI provincial leadership structure. The Medical Director reports directly to the Executive Director of Medical Affairs and indirectly to the Executive Director of the QEH and Community Hospitals East.

The Queen Elizabeth Hospital is a 255 bed acute care hospital serving as both a community hospital to Charlottetown and Queens County, as well as a provincial referral centre for many specialized services. It employs 2000 staff and has a Medical Staff of 197. It is currently in the midst of a multi-phase renewal project, with Phase 1 consisting of a new Emergency Department and Ambulatory Care Centre (both complete) and a new Perioperative Suite scheduled to open spring 2014.

Applicants must have an MD degree or equivalent and must have or be eligible for licensure in PEI. CCFP certification or RCPSC fellowship is preferred. CCPE certification or PMI training is an asset. The successful candidate, a well respected clinician and medical leader, will possess excellent communication and organizational skills, will be effective at engaging physicians, leading change and innovation. A collaborative, participatory leadership style is expected.
