Guidelines

1. *Any applicant, male or female, ages 17-25, residing on the Island and whose mother, grandmother, or guardian is a WI member.*
2. *Applicants may be enrolled in any program of choice, in any form of post-secondary institution, but must be enrolled as a full-time student for a minimum of one school year or 28 weeks.*
3. *Applications will be judged based on self-motivation, community spirit and need. Highest marks are not necessary to receive this scholarship.*
4. *Applicants may apply yearly for scholarship, but may receive it only once.*
5. *Applications should be accompanied by an academic record from school, a personal resume, including a record of previous awards/scholarships, a (250 word essay) on "Women's Institute in the Community" and any (2) letters of recommendation from a former teacher and a clergy or employer.*
6. *The scholarship money will be in the form of a cheque made payable to the recipient and the facility of choice as outlined in #2.*
7. *Applications to be forwarded to WI office by May 31.*
8. *Judges will be selected by the Provincial Board. The decision of the judges will be final.*
