

PART I - COLE CROPS (processing broccoli and cauliflower) cont....

<p>Stage II indemnity rate (un-harvested ac.) FULL OFFSET – between Stage II and Stage III <p style="text-align: right;">Section 24</p></p>	<p>Maximum Indemnity is : For broccoli - 60% of insured value (IV); For cauliflower: - before covering 50% or more of the heads 45% of IV - after covering 50% or more of the heads 60% of IV</p>
<p>Stage III indemnity rate (harvested crop) <p style="text-align: right;">Section 25</p></p>	<p>Maximum indemnity rate is: - 100% of IV if more than 20% of the heads are harvested.</p>
<p>October 31</p>	<p>Final date for harvest; losses after this date are not eligible for insurance coverage.</p>
<p>October 31</p>	<p>Final date for coverage Section 9</p>
<p>November 20</p>	<p>Final date for filing a Production Summary Section 15</p>
<p>November 20</p>	<p>Final date for filing a PROOF of LOSS, in writing Section 20</p>
<p>December 20</p>	<p>Final date to file an appeal of Production Summary or Proof of Loss</p>

- (1) Production to Count is measured in pounds of leafless heads and includes all quantity and grades of product accepted by the processor**
- (2) To qualify for an indemnity on a crop that was not harvested because it was too mature, (ie by-pass acres) the producer must prove evidence that the bypassing resulted from an insurable peril.**
- (3) For Cauliflower the weight used to determine production to count shall be:
 One Box = 24 lbs.**

For the purposes of this plan “**harvest**” shall mean “to reap or to gather in and shall require removal of the crop from the field, for sale or for placement in storage.”
