

PART XXVI - Sugar Beets cont....

Production to count means the amount of the harvested crop meeting one or more of these specific quality standards:

- pp. For the purpose of calculating production to count, the following conversion factors may be used: MT = metric tonnes = 2,204 pounds.
- qq. The insured's production will be adjusted by the Corporation based on records and delivery receipts from the processor.
- rr. The production to count shall be determined from:
 - (i) sales to the processor;
 - (ii) deliveries to the processor;
 - (iii) inventory harvested and stockpiled in the field;
 - (iv) un-harvested acres, at the final harvest deadline.

The Corporation reserves the right to adjust the sales and production for insurable and non-insurable perils in order to establish a final production to count.

- ss. Program requirements:
 - (i) processor will require participation in production insurance as part of their contract;
 - (ii) all producers must participate in production insurance and purchase maximum coverage.
- tt. Notwithstanding clause 17(3) and 17(10), the insured may elect 80% coverage if more than three consecutive years of field data have been provided and have been accepted by the Corporation.
- uu. For the purposes of calculating production or production to count, the volume of sugar beets stored in a horizontal pile shall be determined by using the formula:
Length x width x average height x 40 lbs./cu. ft. / 2,204 = tonnes.
