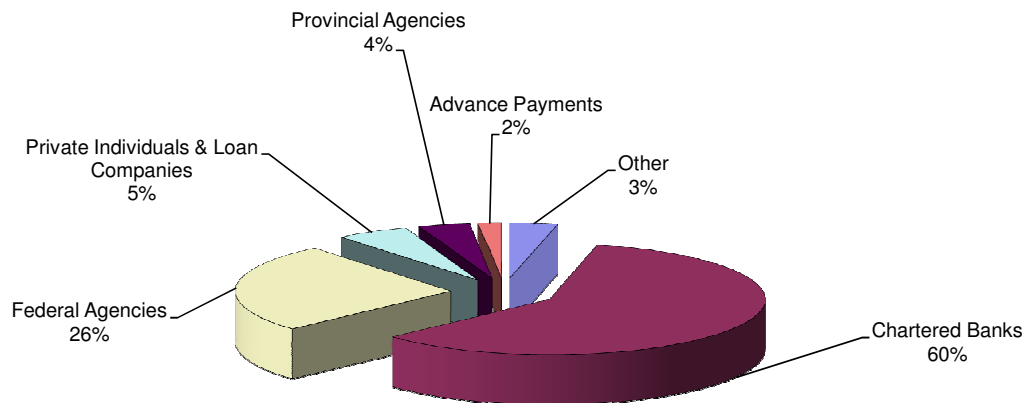

**Source of Lenders, Prince Edward Island, 1999**



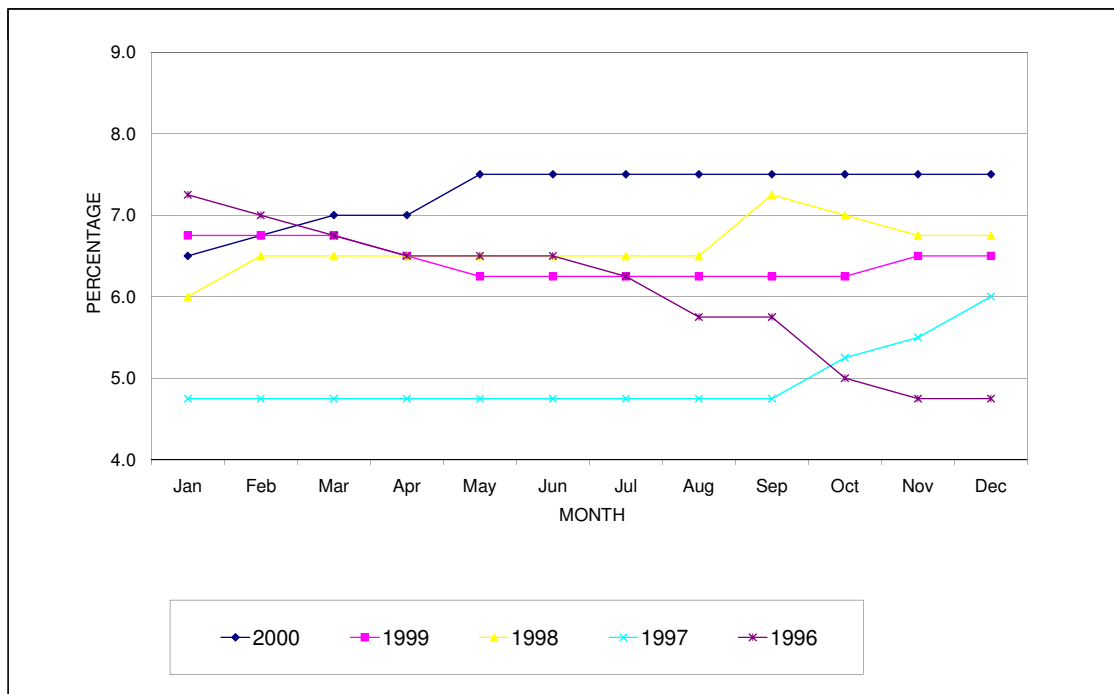

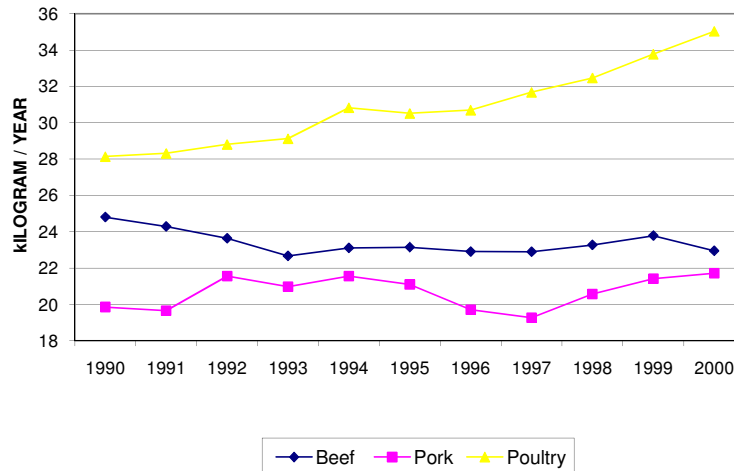

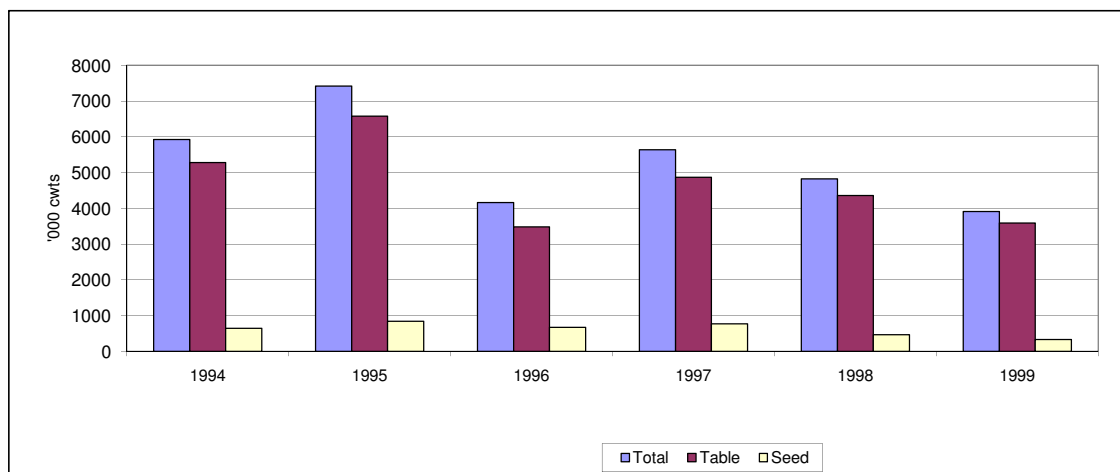
