Source of Lenders, Prince Edward Island, 1998

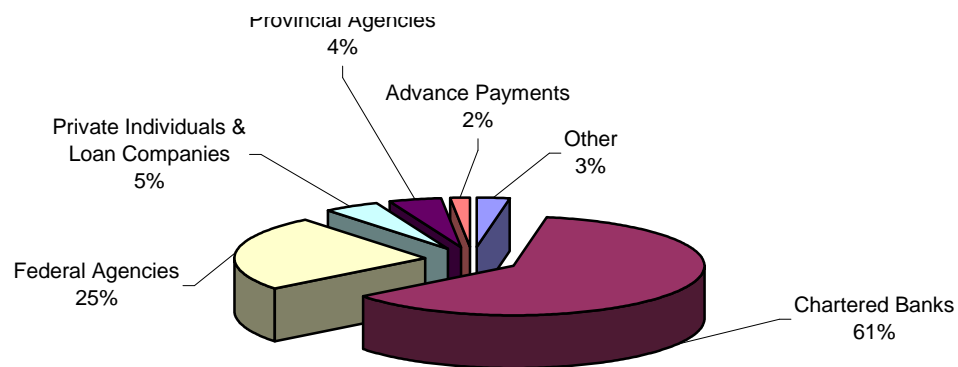

Canadian Prime Interest Rates

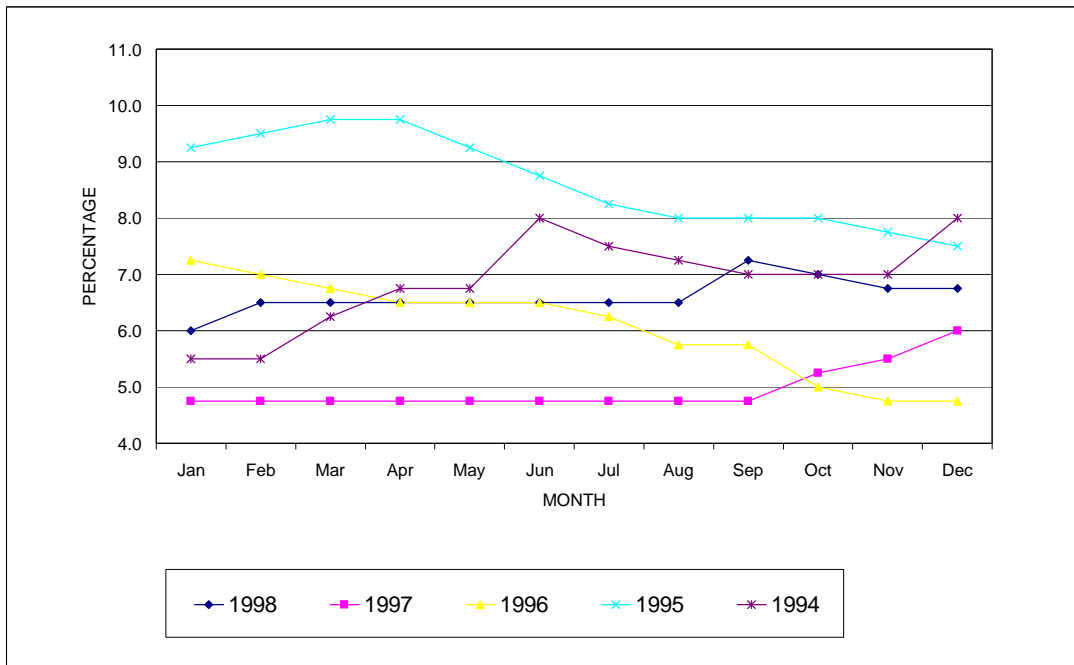

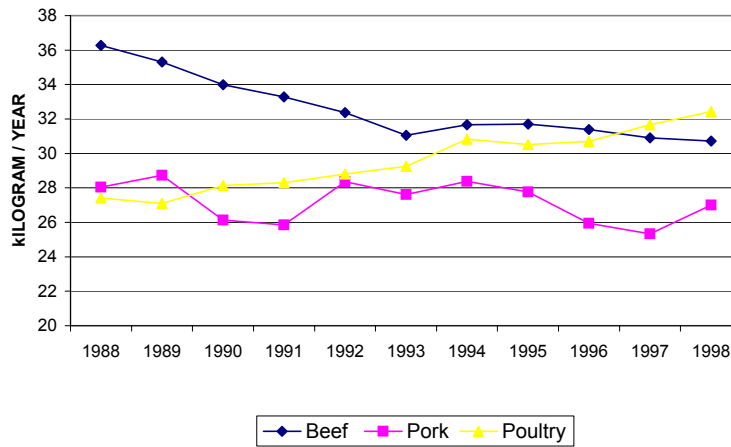

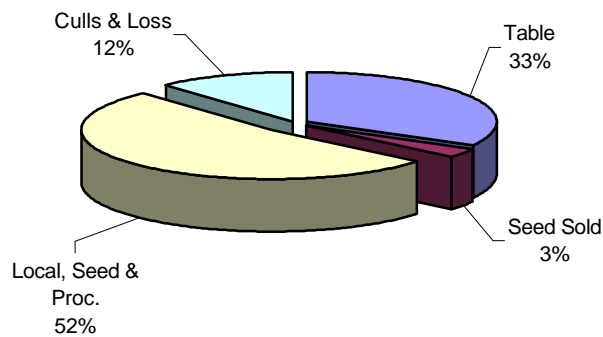
