

Prince Edward Island Beverage Container Management System



Changes Beginning May 3, 2008

Effective **May 3, 2008**, legislative changes will allow the sale of new beverage containers in stores across PEI and will also establish a new deposit and return system.

With these changes, most beverage containers sold, with the exception of dairy products, will carry a deposit and will be worth a cash refund when returned to one of the province's ten licensed depots. Resources from this system will be used to ensure containers are properly recycled and will fund projects that protect and enhance Prince Edward Island's environment.

Prince Edward Island's new Beverage Container Management System allows more consumer choice, more incentive to return and recycle beverage containers, and more resources to protect our environment.

How It Works

Container Type	Deposit Paid	Refund
Non-liquor less than 5L	10¢	5¢
Liquor 500 ml or less	10¢	5¢
Liquor greater than 500 ml	10¢ 10¢	10¢
Deposits on refillable domestic beer bottles are completely refundable (\$1.20 per dozen).
