The purpose of this bursary is to provide on-going recognition of the service provided by the employees of Marine Atlantic (Borden - Cape Tormentine Service).

Terms of Bursary:

- a) The Bursary is valued at \$3000.
- b) The selection will be made by the Marine Atlantic Bursary Program Board
- c) Application deadline is April 15, 2009

Selection Criteria:

The successful applicant is chosen based upon:

- ▶ Financial Need
- ▶ Academic Achievement
- ▶ Extra-Curricular Activities

Eligible Applicants:

- ▶ Former employees
- ▶ Dependents (natural, step and/or adopted) living within the same household as a former Marine Atlantic employee who will be entering post-secondary study for the first time in September 2009.

Residency / Employment Criteria:

- a) Employed by Marine Atlantic (Borden-Cape Tormentine Service) between January 1, 1994 to the opening of the Confederation Bridge,
- b) Minimum of 5 years of regular service (3 months of service annually) at the time of termination,
- c) PEI resident during period of employment with Marine Atlantic.

Study Venue:

Applicants must be pursuing post-secondary study at one of the following educational institutions:

- Holland College
- Collège Acadie Î.-P.-É.
