## Addition of Renewable Heating Systems to The PEI Energy Efficiency Loan Program

Provides financing for the implementation of the recommended upgrades – excluding doors and windows – identified in the ecoENERGY Energy Efficiency Evaluation Report.

Only measures recommended in the evaluation report along with the installation of a Renewable Heating System\* are eligible for the PEI Energy Efficiency Loan program.

Renewable Heating Systems include any of the following:

- any EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) or CSA-B415.1-M92 (Canadian Standard Association) wood burning appliance or wood/grain/corn pellet stove;
- any EPA qualified outdoor wood-fired hydronic heater;
- any pellet or wood burning boiler or furnace that achieves an AFUE (Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency) rating of 80% or higher and meets emission requirements for the EPA outdoor wood-fired hydronic heaters; and
- solar warm-air space heaters.

Clients are eligible for financing to a maximum of \$10,000 at the annual rate of interest of six per cent. Depending on the amount borrowed, applicants will pay between \$90 and \$150 per month until the loan principal and interest are paid off.

### **Notes:**

\*Clients must complete energy efficiency upgrades that will increase their EnerGuide score by at least 10 points or achieve a minimum score of 75 prior to adding a secondary heating source. The Office of Energy Efficiency will define the eligibility of each client using the client's audit report and its recommended upgrades.

**Clients who qualify for the PEI ecoENERGY Audit Assistance Program for Low-income Households are eligible for interest-free financing to a maximum of \$10,000 and are also eligible for the Low-income Loan Relief Program**
