ecoENERGY Audit Assistance Program for Low-Income Households

The Office of Energy Efficiency was established in early 2008 to assist Islanders in reducing their energy consumption and minimize the environmental footprint of our daily activities.

The mandate of the Office of Energy Efficiency is to provide Islanders with advice and programs that will promote sustainable energy use and reinforce the importance of sound energy management for the economic, social and environmental well-being of Island residents and businesses.

The Office of Energy Efficiency is also a one-stop centre for provincial and federal energy efficiency programs and services.

The PEI ecoENERGY Audit Assistance Program for Low-Income Households

- Provides financial assistance for an energy audit, performed through the Natural Resources Canada's (NRCan) ecoENERGY Retrofit Program, to low-income homeowners with a household annual income less than \$30,000, or receives the Guaranteed Income Supplement (Seniors) or receives the National Child Benefit.
- The PEI ecoENERGY Audit Assistance Program will pay the full cost of a pre and post retrofit audit to a maximum of \$500 per household.
- To be eligible for the program, the client must own the home and it must be their primary residence.
- The client must register with the Office of Energy Efficiency and complete the PEI ecoENERGY Audit Assistance Program application form now available at www.gov.pe.ca/oeo or beginning April 1 at local Access PEI sites.
- Clients may choose their own audit service company from a list of Natural Resources Canada (NRCan) approved audit service companies. This list is available at the Office of Energy Efficiency, or online at www.gov.pe.ca/oeo as well as the NRCan website at <http://oeo.nrcan.gc.ca/residential/personal/new-home-improvement/contact-advisors.cfm>

Upon completion of the PEI ecoENERGY Audit Assistance Program, clients will have an opportunity to access the PEI Energy Efficiency Loan Program or the PEI Energy Efficiency Grant Program.
