Energy Efficiency Grant Program and Energy Efficiency Windows and Doors Grant Program

The Office of Energy Efficiency was established in early 2008 to assist Islanders in reducing their energy consumption and minimize the environmental footprint of our daily activities.

The mandate of the Office of Energy Efficiency is to provide Islanders with advice and programs that will promote sustainable energy use and reinforce the importance of sound energy management for the economic, social and environmental well-being of Island residents and businesses.

The Office of Energy Efficiency is also a one-stop centre for provincial and federal energy efficiency programs and services.

The PEI Energy Efficiency Grant Program

- Provides a direct subsidy to homeowners for the implementation of recommended upgrades identified in the ecoENERGY Energy Efficiency Evaluation Report.
- All upgrades in the evaluation report are eligible for this program
- The grant will be equal to 15% of the total amount paid on upgrades to a maximum of \$1,500 per household.

*If a client receives a grant for upgrades to windows and doors, the maximum grant amount will be reduced by the amount of the window and door grant.

The PEI Energy Efficiency Windows and Doors Grant Program

- Clients who install qualified windows and/or doors will receive a grant of \$40 per installed window or door.
- Windows and doors must be Energy Star[®] qualified for the PEI climate zone to be eligible for the grant.
- The maximum amount of this grant is \$500.

Note: If a client has applied for the Energy Efficiency Loan Program, the client is not eligible for the Energy Efficiency Grant Program. Clients who are installing windows can apply for the Energy Efficiency Windows and Doors Program.
